

COVID-19 Measures

The Expo 2020 Dubai team want to make sure that your visit is enjoyable and safe. To ensure this, they have implemented several precautionary measures across the entire site.

Prior to Arrival

Please do not visit Expo 2020 Dubai if you are suffering from any health symptoms associated with COVID-19, if you have been in close contact with an individual confirmed as COVID-19 positive or are under any quarantine orders.

On-Site Measures



Thermal cameras at arrival points to check the temperature of visitors before the entry to the site



Social distancing regulations of at least two metres between people



Visitors are required to always wear face masks



All venues and common areas are regularly cleaned and sanitised



Hand sanitiser stations are positioned at regular intervals throughout the site



Appropriate facilities and specialist staff are available to manage any potential media issues on site

COVID-19 Measures

Entry requirements

Visitors aged 18 years and above must present proof of any vaccine recognised by their national government or a negative PCR test taken within the previous 72 hours.

Testing

Unvaccinated visitors 18 years and above, holding the following ticket types are eligible for a free PCR test:

- 1-Day Ticket: 1 free PCR test
- Multi-Day Pass: Maximum of 3 free PCR tests per month

The following visitors are not eligible for a free PCR test:

- Visitors who are fully vaccinated or partially vaccinated (one dose)
- Visitors with a Season Pass, including Jubilee Experience, Premium Experience and Family Package

Please take the PCR test at least one day before your visit to Expo as results will take up to 10 hours.

Proceed to the DHA Expo 2020 Testing Facility at the Expo World Carpark K. The centre is open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week and has drive-thru lanes and a walk-thru tent.

COVID-19 Measures

To claim the free PCR test, you must:

- Show your valid 1-Day Ticket or Multi-Day Pass
- Show your original and valid passport or Emirates ID. It is mandatory to show the physical document
- Emirates ID holders should be ready to show their vaccination history on the Al Hosn app, if asked
- Test results will be shared via the Al Hosn app and SMS. The SMS will have a link for you to download the results

How has the Australian Pavilion prepared for COVID-19 precautions?

Australia takes the COVID-19 situation seriously and the necessary precautions have been taken to ensure the pavilion is a COVID-safe area for visitors, aligning with all Expo 2020 Dubai health and safety guidelines.

This includes mandatory mask wearing, always keeping a physical distance of at least two metres, regular sanitisation of all venues and common areas and hand-sanitiser stations. Expo 2020 Dubai has implemented appropriate medical facilities and ensures specialist staff are available to manage any medical issues that may arise.

Given the uncertain nature and limitations around travel during the current pandemic, the Australian Pavilion has developed facilities and programming that enable Australians to participate virtually across a range of business and cultural events. Immersive, 360-degree videos will be created to facilitate online augmented and virtual reality tours, providing offshore visitors a captivating insight of the pavilion experience.

Is the COVID-19 vaccine required to attend events at the Australian Pavilion?

Yes. As per Expo 2020 Dubai directive, visitors aged 18 years and above must present proof of any vaccine recognised by their national government or a negative PCR test taken within the previous 72 hours.

Will I need to download the Al Hosn application to show my vaccination certificate or Negative PCR Test?

No. A copy of your vaccination certificate or negative PCR results whether it is digitally available or physically printed will be sufficient.

Will temperature checks be undertaken to attend events at the Australian Pavilion?

No. Temperature checks won't be undertaken at the Australian Pavilion.

Are the Australian Pavilion staff vaccinated?

Yes. All the Australian Pavilion staff members are fully vaccinated.
