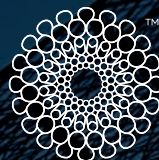
Roving Entertainment

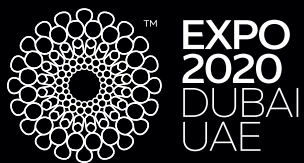
